"Being Mortal" live streaming event planning: On September 25<sup>th</sup>, TSO will join Eastside Neighbors Network (ENN) and KCLS to host a live-streaming conversation with Dr. Atul Gawande, author of Being Mortal: Medicine and What Matters in the End." The talk is presented by Beacon Hill Village in Boston and the Village to Village Network, of which ENN is a member. ENN grew out of a 2015 TELOS class based on the book, taught by Ellen Berg.
