# What does TSO do?

TSO (the TELOS Student Organization):

- › Supports the TELOS academic program
- › Creates opportunities for intellectual and social interaction
- › Manages a web site – your source for information about TSO events and links to TELOS courses and instructor biographies.

An elected, student-run, volunteer Council guides and coordinates three standing committees:

- › **Curriculum Committee:** Seeks out and reviews courses and instructors to enrich and diversify the curriculum. Manages the popular “Coffee and Wisdom” speaker series and Quarter Break Seminars for TELOS students.
- › **Marketing Committee:** Plans and implements strategies to build awareness of TELOS in the community and promote enrollment in classes. Oversees quarterly TELOScope newsletter.
- › **Events Committee:** Conducts programs to build community. Organizes the summer picnic and winter holiday party, partially subsidized by the TSO. Manages occasional special events and conducts the annual elections for TSO Council positions.

All TELOS students are eligible to serve on committees or run for office. You are welcome to attend monthly Council and Committee meetings.
