Reports from Officers

Vice President: Jerry Bunce

- b. More than 50 classes for Winter Quarter creates a greater variety, but may result in less attendance.
- c. TELOS needs further communication concerning the marketing.
 - 1. Unknown is the distribution of the 200 TELOS only catalog.
 - 2. Unknown is exactly how the foundation finances are used for the TELOS only catalog.

- d. A one-page advertisement in their catalog costs \$1,000.
