I. Minutes: The Curriculum Committee Minutes of March 18, 2021 were approved as submitted

II. Administration

1. Summer Quarter registration begins April 22. Thirty-five classes are listed for enrollment
2. Mid-May is the deadline for Fall Quarter course submissions

III. CC Info

1. Eric Zocher, TELOS Webmaster, reviewed the seven sections of TELOS informatio that can be accessed on the TELOS Website. These sections include Welcome, TELOS, Courses, TSO, Calendar/Events, Other Info, Contact Us. He also discussed subsections of these categories
2. Jan Reha conducted a survey of other retiree programs in the area and compared them to TELOS.
 - a. The main retiree programs are at North Seattle Community College and Edmonds Community College, but Seattle Central is offering 10 classes for Spring.
 - b. Instructor salary range is \$40/hour at Edmonds to \$45/hour at Seattle Central both are above the \$35/hour rate paid by Bellevue College
 - c. The retiree programs in other locations are not requiring curriculum design or CTC training
 - d. Private class offerings are held at Providence Point where 56% of the instructors live. Classes are in physical fitness and art. Pay is \$45/hour.
 - e. OSHER presents classes in partnership with the University of Washington that are 3-5 weeks in length. Pay is a \$50 honorarium
3. CTC Training is for classroom control, and is required by the State. It is primarily of value to Bellevue College, since there is nothing in the program that is applicable to TELOS
