Reports from Officers

1. "The purpose of TELOS is to support the policies of Bellevue College in all of its decisions and activities."
2. Jerry Harkleroad was able to contact Governor Locke at Bellevue College's "Sunrise Breakfast". Gov. Locke was amenable to meeting with TELOS representatives to discuss ongoing issues. Reports from Committees

Events: Steve Denison

1. Candidates are proposed for every office in the upcoming election.
2. Steve used a Google form to create a ballot that requires only a button response to register results
3. Steve is planning with Donna for an in-person return to North Campus welcome

Curriculum: Donna Oberembt

1. Only 65% of those registered to attend Seminars are attending. Among the options discussed to alleviate the low attendance was levying a monthly fee in order to attend any or all Seminars
2. Donna is working with the Events Committee to plan an event possibly in the Fall welcoming people back to in-person classes. It is hoped that by involving people on a social level interest in TELOS will increase
3. Donna mailed a survey to 40 inactive instructors. So far two surveys have been returned with remarks on the need for help with technology and classroom support

Marketing: Jerry Harkleroad

1. Requested biographies from three instructors for inclusion in the TELOS Course Schedule, but

had no response. He then inquired of Jerry Bunce who submitted a biography.

2. Promotion of TELOS by the use of 2-foot by 2-foot signs placed strategically around Bellevue was suggested

New Business

1. Chris Steele conducted a survey of the RCW's governing the boundaries of the colleges and technical schools which are still governed by the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges., There appears to be an effort to encourage schools to share available resources
2. Further information was requested concerning Andrea-Smtih-Clark's suggestion to include acknowledgment of the traditional lands of the Coast Salish people at seminars and classes
