Special Seminars During Quarter Break

A popular past TELOS instructor, **Alessandro Regio**, has agreed to facilitate two *seminar series* during the break between Fall and Winter TELOS quarters this year:

Arab Spring: 3 Years On—December 15-18 (M, T, W, Th from 10:00 am to noon)

A survey of four countries in the Middle East which experienced the phenomenon known as the “Arab Spring”. We will look at the causes, the happenings, and the current situation in Egypt, Tunisia, Qatar and Syria. You will leave this course with a better understanding of the movement of peoples in these four countries and an increased awareness of their lives .

Cost: \$20 for all four sessions.

Human Rights: Theory and Reality—December 15-18 (M, T, W, Th from 1:00pm to 3:00pm)

Human Rights are the crown jewel of the post-war years in the Western World, but even after the atrocities of WWII, no right can be said to have been grown overnight. Indeed, many of the rights in that declaration can still be considered “works in progress”. This course will offer a powerful overview of many of the rights included in the United Nations Declaration of Human Rights and the resistance that they face in today's world.

Enjoy a guided tour of one of the world's most spectacular aviation and space museums. See the British Concorde jet liner, Presidential Air Force One, WWI and II aircraft, the Space Shuttle, Lunar Lander and much more.

Tours will include the Museum's extensive aircraft collection and the topic of "Space and Space Exploration." Ron Hobbs, TELOS instructor, will conduct two separate tours on Space Exploration (*) while two other tours of the aircraft collection(**) will be conducted by Museum docents.
