SUMMER PICNIC - Saturday, August 18 at the North Bellevue Community Center

Steve Denison reported that Bellevue College has become more proactive in getting bills paid. The rental fee reimbursement for the picnic reservation at the North Bellevue Community Center for the picnic has already been paid.

Tim Hay brought up the issue of reimbursement -- Bellevue College doesn't like reimbursements and wants expenditures approved ahead of time; however, if you have a receipt (such as for reserving the community center that may not allow for pre-approval without jeopardizing the reservation), BC will provide reimbursement.

For the picnic, Steve investigated having box lunches. The drawbacks were that the lunches were made the day before so they were old on the day of the picnic, and we needed an exact headcount and had to pay for each lunch whether it was eaten or not. He also considered having picnic guests make their own sandwiches from a selection of breads, meats and topping, and was told that it takes too long for people to assemble their own sandwiches.

Susan Magan will be catering the picnic. Ideas for the food selection were: Cold beef meatloaf with ketchup, Fried Chicken, Pasta Salad, Vegetarian, Burgers, Vegi-burgers, hot dogs. We want to have a picnic atmosphere.

Bellevue College requires a 4-hour window for all events so the length of the picnic will be 10:00 AM - 2:00 PM but guests will only be there from 11:30AM-1:30PM. Setup and clean-up will occur before and after the announced picnic schedule.

Raj will send out an invitation to the TSO email list and people can RSVP directly to that email. An 8x11 flyer will be distributed to classes that are in session. A follow-up email will be sent.

The picnic will include a business meeting and the topic will be TELOS tuition fee increases. (Increases will be \$79 - \$99 - \$125 - \$139 over the next 4? years.)
